DESCRIPTION: This course blends practical instruction with real-world discussion to explore the evolving responsibilities of today's code official. Participants will examine essential interpersonal and leadership skills—customer service, communication, legal awareness, political dynamics, and sound decision-making within the building department.

Through scenario-based examples and guided discussion, attendees gain insight into how experienced professionals navigate complex situations, balance competing priorities, and apply good judgment in the gray areas of enforcement and administration. Designed to be practical and engaging, the course encourages thoughtful dialogue and provides strategies participants can apply immediately in their daily work.
